STAGING

 MECHANICALLY IN FRONT OF THEM.
- O IN MOVEMENTS II AND III THE READERS OR A DIRECTOR MAY STAGE MOVEMENT TO EMPHASIZE, JUXTAPOSE AND CLARIFY THE SPECIFIED EMOTIONS. UTILIZATION OF THE WHOLE STAGE, INCLUDING THE READERS LEVELS OF HEIGHT ON THE STAGE, IS ENCOURAGED.
